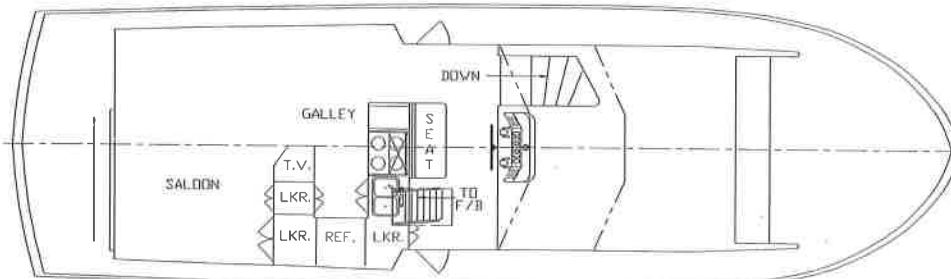

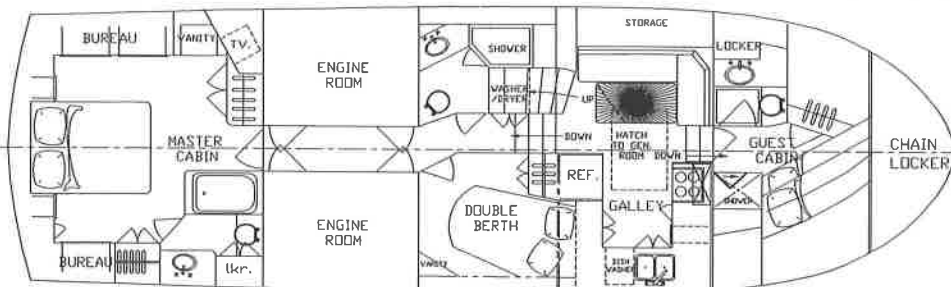
52 Deckhouse Saloon Deck Plan



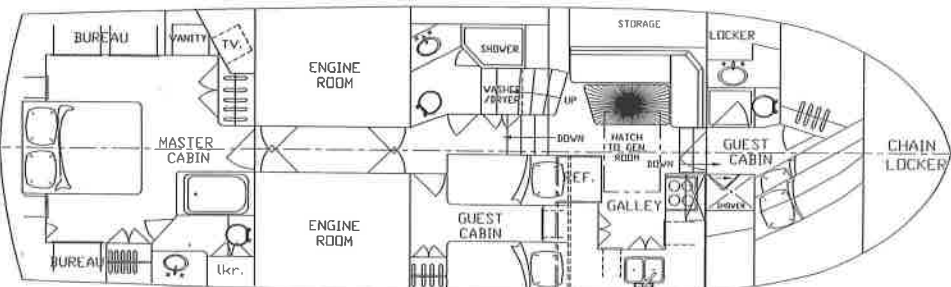
52 Extended Deckhouse Saloon Deck Plan

The Marquessa is Jefferson Yachts' grande dame: regal, elegant, in command of the seas. So imposing is this magnificent motor yacht that only the most self-assured yachtsmen approach her helm.

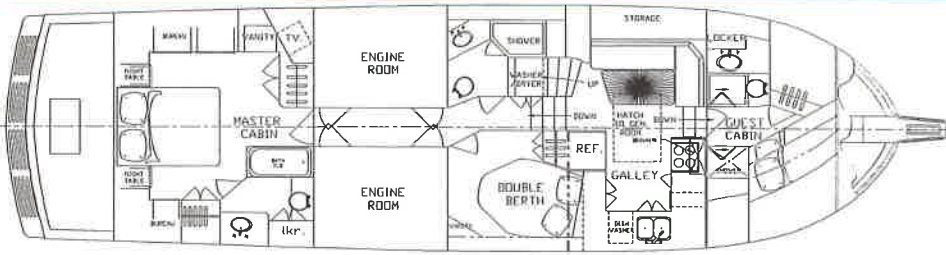
The Marquessa was designed to be accommodating on longer cruises—a veritable home at sea. Available in standard deckhouse, extended deckhouse and extended deckhouse with cockpit models, the yacht offers at least three, and up to four staterooms, depending on the floor plan selected. Because of Jefferson Yachts' characteristic versatility, an additional double berth may be converted from dinette or lounge in each plan.

The beauty of this boat begins with her striking exterior. The streamlined figure, more than 52 or 56 feet long, and 16 feet wide, belies her rugged preparedness for heavy seas. There's Jefferson Yachts' exclusive professionally engineered, tank-tested hull design for maximum performance at lower horsepower ratios. Solidly constructed of hand laid-up, heavily-reinforced fiberglass, this hull was built to compliment the powerful thrust of the twin 550 BHP Johnson & Towers 6V92TA Detroit Diesel engines. High-gloss gel covers and protects the exterior, with a contrasting boot top stripe adding to the craft's sleekness.

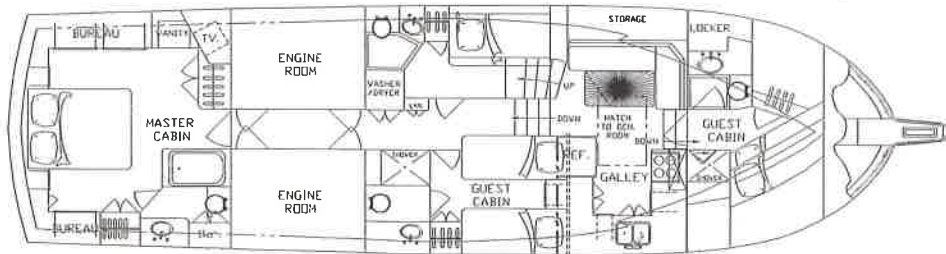
On the deckhouse model, there's a spacious sundeck for relaxing in comfort, with room for a wet bar, if you choose. Up on the flying bridge is a commanding view, a wet sink, and more room to entertain! The full controls and instrumentation of the upper helm station are duplicated in the lower helm, forward in the saloon.

In the extended deckhouse model, you'll find one of the grandest saloons ever designed, lined and trimmed with handsome, hand-rubbed teakwood ready for individual appointment. You may choose to have your galley here on the saloon deck, allowing for a fourth stateroom

on the cabin deck, or you may have a galley and dinette below.

Even-though the Marquessa is a production yacht, several floor plan choices allow owners considerable personalization.

Aft, on the cabin deck, is the huge master stateroom, featuring queen berth, two bureaus, double-size hanging lockers, and master head

with tub, shower and vanity. Forward of this stateroom are the lead-lined foam-insulated engine rooms. The rest of the cabin floor is up to you.

The mid-ship guest cabin may have two single berths or one double, with a head and separate shower opposite. Continuing forward can be the galley and dinette area—

or another guest cabin, with lounge area. Yet another guest cabin is situated in the bow, with upper and lower berths.

For a complete explanation of the available options, see the deck plan drawings presented elsewhere in this flyer.

The majesty of the Marquessa extends to her long list of standard equipment, including Aqua Air® Marine Air Conditioning with zone control and reverse cycle heating, a 15KW Westerbeke diesel generator with sound cover, full-size household appliances, cultured marble lavatory counter tops and bowls, camphor-wood-lined hanging lockers, teakwood cabinetry, walls, parquet floors and joinery, a Halon fire extinguisher system, circuit-breaker protected AC and DC electrical systems, and much, much more.
